Professional Development

Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965, as Amended by the Every Student Succeeds Act of 2015, section 8101(42) defines "professional development," specifically noting that the professional development activities are sustained (not stand-alone, 1-day, or short term workshops), intensive, collaborative, job-embedded, data-driven, and classroom-focused.

Purple Star schools are required to have a Military-Connected Youth Liaison complete professional development activities related to supporting students in military families. Each point of contact is required to participate in a professional development training focused on military families. Applicants may use the *Military Children in Ohio's Schools* training provided by the Ohio Department of Education or another professional development opportunity of their choice.
